Medium of Instruction for Teaching and Examinations

- The language of instruction will be decided in mutual consultation with the students and may include Gujarati, Hindi, English, or a combination of these.
- Exam question papers will be available in Gujarati, Hindi, and English. Students may respond in the language they are most comfortable with (Gujarati, Hindi, and English).

Course Delivery Structure and Approach

- Lectures and selected practicals will be conducted 4 to 5 days per week, for 2 hours per day.
- Lectures, practicals, field visits/works, seminars, internal exams, final exams, and viva will be held in person.
- Assignments and project work/dissertation can be completed externally.
- Students who are unable to attend selected lectures or practicals in person may join online, with prior permission.
- Every two months, an in-person session of 4 days (may get extend upto 2 more days based on requirement) will be organized for selected activities (seminars, practicals, field visits/works, exams, viva), and attendance is mandatory.

Attendance and Participation Requirements

- A minimum of 75% attendance is mandatory to be eligible for final exams and viva.
- Students are expected to cooperate and actively participate in all academic activities, including lectures, practicals, field visits, seminars, assignments, and project work/dissertation.
