

Structured Feedback on Curriculum

The department and university have a structured feedback system in place. This involves a questionnaire covering aspects such as curriculum, teaching-learning evaluation, administrative support, and more. Feedback is gathered from students, teachers, employer and alumni by individual departments and analysed using standard statistical techniques. The goal of this analysis is to identify the strengths and areas for improvement within the curriculum and to monitor the effects of any changes made in response to previous feedback. The analysis is organized into four categories: student feedback, alumni feedback, employer feedback, and teacher feedback.




Student Feedback Analysis Report and Action Taken

IQAC of Kachchh University collected feedbacks/suggestions from students of the university during the 2016–2018, 2017-19, 2018-20, 2019-21, 2020-22, 2021-23, 2022-24 academic year. 




Quality education

About 100% of the students gave all admission and registration-related points a positive rating where excellent and very good rating were approx 33 and 35 % respectively.


















Education Quality
