

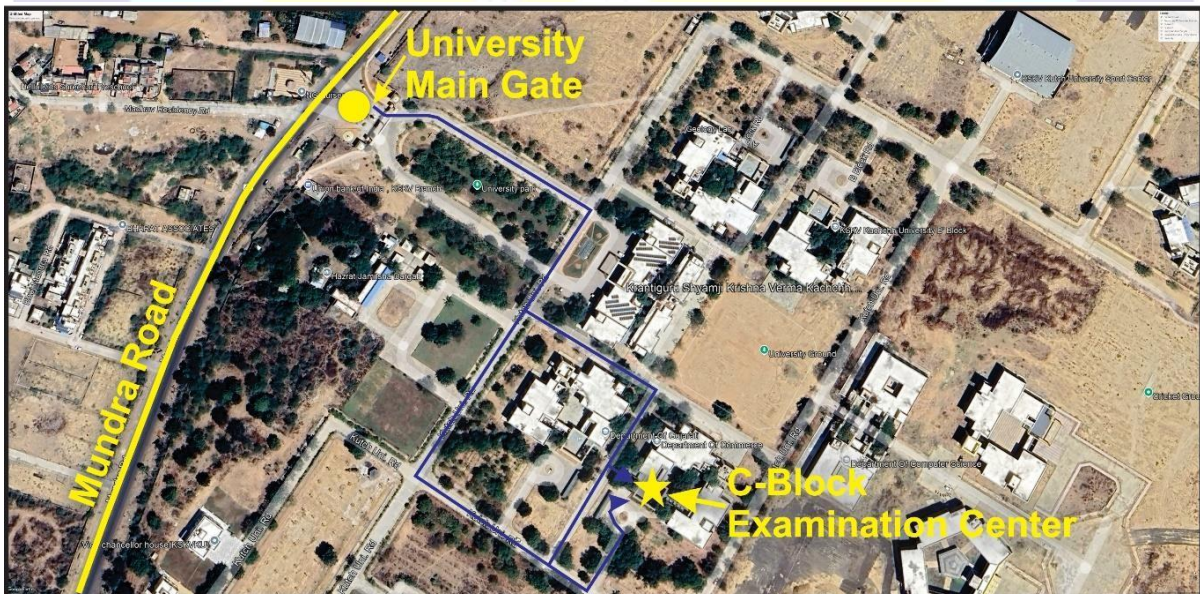

Important Information:

1. **Name of the Examination:** Ph. D. Entrance Test- 2026 (PET-2026)
2. **Date of the Examination:** 10th May, 2026
3. **Day of the Examination:** Sunday
4. **Reporting Time:** Before 10:00 a.m.
5. **Time of the Examination:** 11:00 a.m. to 01: 00 p.m.
6. **Examination Center:** C- Block, Krantiguru Shyamji Krishna Verma Kachchh University Campus, Mundra Road, Near Changleshwar Mahadev Temple, Bhuj, Kachchh, Gujarat (India).

Important Guidelines:

1. All candidates must report to the examination venue before 10:00 a.m. with their respective **Hall Tickets and an original government-issued Photo identity card** (as mentioned in the "Instructions" section of the Hall Ticket).
2. The candidate's name on the Photo ID must match the name printed on the Admit Card. In case of a name change, the candidate must present an original Gazette notification, Marriage Certificate, or Affidavit. Additionally, the photograph on the Admit Card must match the one on the government-issued Photo ID.

3. The PET-2026 Question Paper will consist of two sections:

- **Section-I:** Research Methodology
- **Section-II:** Subject-Specific Questions
- Each section will contain 50 multiple-choice questions (MCQs), with four options per question, totaling 100 questions. Each question carries one mark. The examination duration is two hours without a break.

4. PET-2026 will be conducted in mono or bilingual languages as detailed in the table below:

5. Syllabus:

6. **Passing Criteria:** Candidates must secure a minimum of 50% aggregate marks across both sections (with a 5% relaxation for SC/ST/SEBC/PH/EWS candidates). No negative marking will be applied.

7. Candidates must bring a blue or black ballpoint pen. The use of pencils, ink pens, or gel pens is not allowed in PET-2026.

8. Candidates must correctly fill in their details, including seat number, question paper name, and set number, and sign the OMR sheet using a blue/black ballpoint pen. A second OMR sheet will not be provided under any circumstances.

9. Before leaving the examination hall, candidates must ensure that their Admit Card and OMR sheet are signed by the invigilator.

10. **Strictly Prohibited Items:** Mobile phones, tablets, laptops, smartwatches, or any other electronic gadgets are strictly prohibited. Possession of such items or any incriminating material will lead to immediate disqualification and cancellation of candidature.

11. The examination will be conducted under CCTV surveillance and video recording. Impersonation will result in immediate disqualification.
12. Candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination hall before the conclusion of PET-2026. The OMR sheet must be submitted to the invigilator before leaving.
13. Candidates may take the question paper with them after the examination. Scanned copies of the OMR sheets will be sent to candidates via email on the same day.
14. The Question Paper and Answer Key will be uploaded on the university website on the same day.
15. The provisional result will be declared on the same day as PET-2026. Candidates will have at least two days to review the Question Paper, Answer Key, and Provisional Result and raise any queries.
16. The final result will be declared after addressing all queries raised by candidates.
17. After the final result declaration, the university will provide further guidance on the Ph.D. admission process for candidates who are exempted from the PET-2026 as well as successfully qualify PET-2026.
